

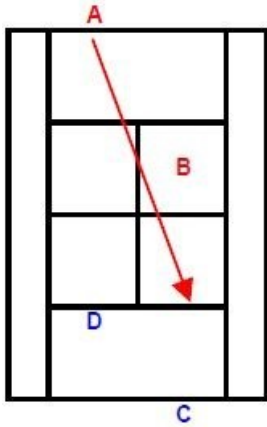


Towerpoint Tennis Club - EVSTL Coman Tiebreak Procedure

The Coman Tiebreak ensures that a server in doubles will serve on the same side that he/she has been serving on for the whole set. It also equalizes difficult playing factors such as strong wind or sun.

In a tiebreak, the player whose turn it is to serve shall serve the **first point from the deuce court**; after the first point, **the players shall change ends** and the following two points shall be served by the player of the opposing team due to serve next, **starting with the ad court**, changing ends after every four points until the end of the tiebreak game. Switch sides after points: 1, 5, 9, 13, 17,

Then Switch Sides



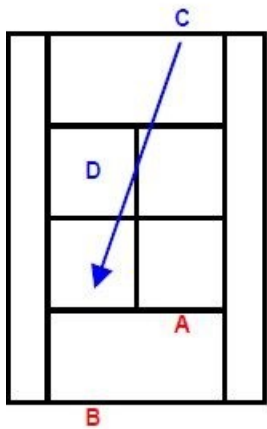
Set Tiebreak: First to 7 points, win by 2 point margin.

First server - next server in regular rotation.

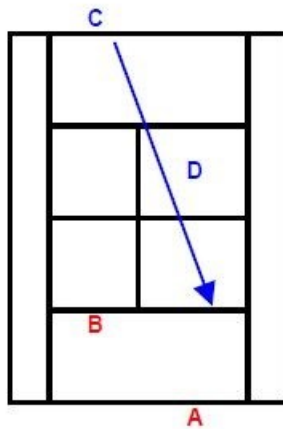
Match Tiebreak: First to 10 points, win by 2 point margin.

First server - next in regular rotation. **Except: after a set tie break - server is the team that was the first receiver in the set tiebreak.**

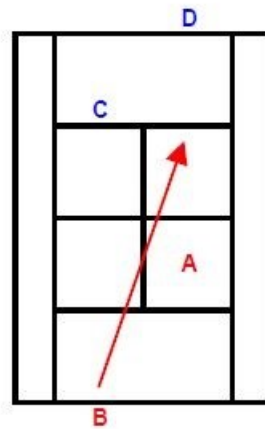
