**Definitions:**

**Unforced errors** – An unreturned ball that should have been returned safely by a player at this level; also a double fault; an out ball; netted ball.

**Winner** – A ball landing safely, which an opposing player, at any level, could not reach for a return; also an ace.

**Forced error** – A ball having such a pace, placement or spin, that a player at this level should not be expected to return it; e.g. a service winner; an overhead smash; a topspin lob; a well placed drop shot. A FORCED ERROR IS TALLIED AS A WINNER FOR THE FORCING PLAYER.

The Evaluated Player is placed into a typical doubles court setting. Three members will be selected to play with the evaluated player by the Rating Committee. The evaluated player is then paired with each member for up to four games or sufficient games to enable the rating committee to perform a fair evaluation.
