Ten Cap Overview

What is it? Ten Cap is a system of recording players' league matches to calculate their skill rating and to calculate how their skill is improving throughout the season. This system is now being promoted by the EVSTL league. It is expected to generate more balanced league matches.

Benefits:

- Easier for captains to pair up partners and to match up teams with opposing captains.
- Easier record keeping.
- Easy method of communication for captains and their teams, for presidents and club members, and for posting notices.
- Easier to “draft” players and end up with more even teams.

Ratings:

- The **lower** the number the **better** your rating.
- The rating of a doubles team is the **average** of the two players' ratings.
- The ratings act as a predictor of the outcome of the match.
- 2 points difference in rating = 1 game difference per set.
- Ratings calculations take into account:
 - The score of the match

- Your rating, your partner's rating and your opponents' ratings
- Winner of the match.
- Your rating will improve if you play better than the system predicts and your rating will decline if you do worse than the system predicts, regardless of whether or not you win or lose.
- The accuracy of the ratings increases with each match.
